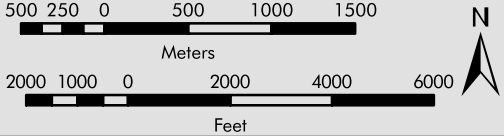

NOTES:
'Core habitat' depicts the most viable habitat for rare species and natural communities. 'Supporting natural landscape' buffers and connects 'core habitat' and identifies large, naturally vegetated blocks that are relatively free from the impact of roads and other development. Contiguous woodlands were identified from the 1999 McConnell land use for only those areas outside the 'core' and 'supporting' areas.
