


WHO LIVES IN TISBURY?

THE PROJECTED INCREASE **OF TISBURY'S YEAR-ROUND** POPULATION IS COMPARABLE TO THE ISLAND'S


PROJECTED YEAR-ROUND **POPULATION FROM 2010 TO 2035:**








TISBURY HOUSING AND AFFORDABILITY

TISBURY HAS THE MOST YEAR-ROUND HOUSING ON THE ISLAND

48% YEAR-ROUND HOUSING

Island-Wide, the housing is 38% year-round.

TISBURY HAS THE MOST DIVERSE HOUSING ON THE ISLAND

70% owner-occupied



These figures do not include seasonal rentals. Island-wide the housing is 22% renter-occupied. State-wide it is 38%.

82% single-family housing



Island-wide, the housing stock is 91% single-family housing.
