A “Complete Street” is one that is designed to provide safe access for all users including pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists and transit users. The end result of the Complete Street Prioritization Plan will be a listing of potential projects to be funded through MassDOT’s Complete Streets Funding Program.

An example of a Complete Streets Project could be enhancements to an existing transit stop, implementation of a bicycle facility, improved American with Disabilities (ADA) compliant sidewalk and associated ramps.

The Town of Tisbury wants to hear from the public on their lived experience of getting around town either on foot, bicycle, or public bus. Feedback is also sought with regard to accessibility and ADA compliance/accommodations. By engaging the community through this public outreach effort, the Town of Tisbury hopes to gain a better understanding of the local context and priorities of the community.

Visit the [Prioritization Plan Map](#) to put a dot (or dots) on those locations that need improvement or those locations that currently work well with regard to biking, walking, public transportation and/or accessibility. After visiting the website, users are asked to “ADD A POINT” to the map based on their mode of transportation. For example, a user can select the bicycle icon and “ADD A POINT” to a segment of roadway that does not have any bicycle accommodations.
