

LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE

MINUTES - December 10, 1990

The meeting was held in the Gay Head Town Hall.

Hugh Taylor - Applicant

Bob Lee, Gay Head Planning Board called the meeting to order at 6:08 p.m.
Mr. Clifford noted that Mr. Morgan of the LUPC had been called to attend
a legislative hearing in Edgartown. He was standing in for Rep.Turkington.

Mr. Lee explained the reason for the meeting and indicated that the
Commission, LUPC was seeking comments as to whether the proposal of
Hugh Taylor was a DRI or not.

Ms. Green, LUPC discussed the problem from the standpoint of the
Commission and the LUPC and the confusion surrounding the issue.

Mr. Taylor explained the background and history of the proposal noting
the dates and sequence of events to date. He discussed the special
permit that he was seeking and exactly what he felt he really wanted
to do. He noted that he had seven rentable rooms and wanted a special
permit to exceed the requirement of eight persons in the zoning
ordinance. A discussion of the operation of a restaurant followed.

Mr. Taylor indicated that he did not seek to be a restaurant.

A discussion regarding the Board of Appeals decision followed. The
nature of the decision and the proposal with respect to commercial
activities was discussed at some length.
A discussion of the intent of the ZBA decision and their particular
findings followed.

A discussion of the decision of the Board of Health followed. The
issue of numbers of patrons and the paying for meals was discussed
with respect to what constituted a commercial venture.

A discussion of why the DRI process might be helpful to the proposal
followed.

A further discussion of whether proposal was or was not a DRI followed.

Mr. Lee suggested that the applicant consider applying for a special
permit as well as a variance. A discussion of this matter followed.

There being no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
