

Vineyard Wind under review by BOEM

BOEM (Bureau of Ocean Energy Management) is scoping its Impact Statement on Vineyard Wind's Construction and Operations Plan. This is a chance to comment on what needs to be addressed in the Impact Statement. MVC and local boards will review for approval the transmission line and any onshore facilities, but most of the project lies beyond the 3-mile limit of MVC's and the towns' jurisdiction. This comment period is a chance to be heard by BOEM; the primary chance for the offshore parts of the plan. Comments will be received until April 30. 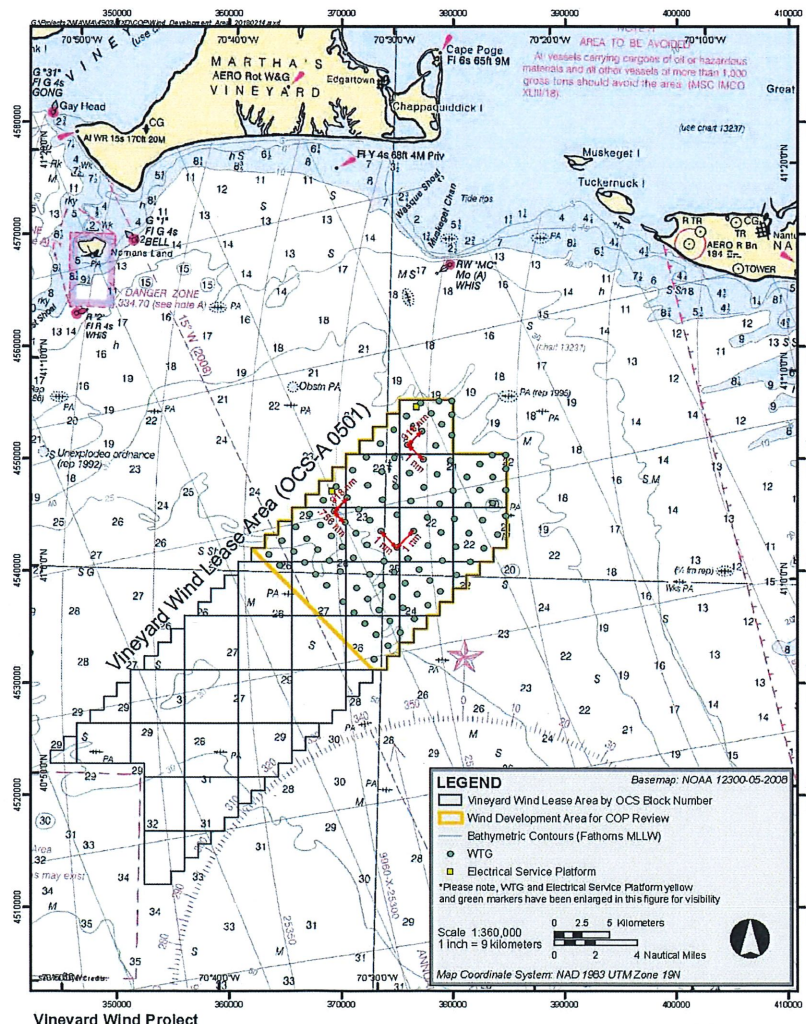
