Old/New Business

Update on the sea wall project. CLE Engineering

Conservation Commissioner Joan Hughes introduced Carlos Pena of CLE Engineering who presented a slide show of the seawall project, which has been a seven year project. The planning phase of the project, drawings and bid documents should be finished by the end of July.

Update on improvements to Fire House Lane

Selectman Vail and Highway Superintendent Combra discussed the drainage and plantings planned for Fire House Road. It is the Town’s responsibility to restore the road near the construction site. It is not included in the overall construction budget. Mr. Combra has estimated the cost to be about \$10,000 and will be drawn from the contingency fund.

Update on Niantic Park Playground. Park Commissioner Amy Billings

Greg Ehrman talked about the plans and fundraising for the playground at Niantic Park. There will be a community build from October 14 to October 18, 2015. Niantic Park is also fundraising for equipment for the rest of the park. Donations for benches for the park can be made with Friends of Oak Bluffs.
