Please hear our concerns; they need to find an alternative place for the Cell Phone Tower being proposed for residential lot located at 14 Sampson Ave, Chappaquiddick. These videos can be seen all over You Tube these tower cause real threats. Not even one accident will be worth it, my property is 20ft from ground Zero, my grandchildren play in this area. Please don't sleep on this; we need your help now to save our neighborhood. We have owned our home for 14 years and we had rented at the same home 15 years before given the opportunity to purchase it.

This Cell Tower is long past the need for personal use on residential Zoned property. AT&T and Mr Fynbo should be buying secluded property to grow their cell tower business, one such property is for sale offering 3.40 acres located on 9 Ambers Way; just 1/2 mile away on a dead end street. We are not the big Million Dollar property owners on Chappy, we are a small neighborhood of hardworking people that can't afford the drop in property value this project will cause.

At first sight of Fynbo's antenna it should have been made to be taken down, the board made a mistake allowing this to continue by grandfathering his antennas. Please if you have not gone out to Chappy to see the damages his will do to a small residential area, I beg you to do so.

We live in small homes, on small 1/2 area lots. We see our neighbors homes, there are not acres of trees that will camouflage these towers; they get bigger and bigger with every change he's made adding more and more weight. Now they need a bigger & tall tower for AT&T equipment. It doesn't stop there; already there is talk about adding other cell service companies and taller towers.

AT&T spokesperson stated [in response to the question what would happen if it falls] "the towers don't fall; they are made to collapse onto itself. So the picture they want the laymen to have is a 180' tower is going to neatly collapse onto itself in a neat pile of mettle and not disturb the houses next door 10ft & 20 Ft away.

Please don't be fooled, this is a bad news bear creeping in, don't be indifferent to our plea because you can't see it from the ferry, or from the beach or even you own home; we see it - we see it from the yard, from our deck, and from our windows.

This is an improper placement for this Towering Business.
This is a low to medium income area of Chappy, the kind of neighborhood this commission was put in place to help protect
I am respectfully asking that you not approve this project to move forward at 14 Sampson Ave.
