Hi Chris,

Could you please respond to the following questions from staff?

- Is there a wind rating for the proposed racks, or are there otherwise assurances that they will be able to withstand hurricane-force winds?

The wind rating is load D or 140mph at full capacity. The plans will be stamped and certified once we give a deposit, once the final plan is approved. The load rating is on the rack plans in the original submittal as well.

- How does the proposal or stormwater plan account for potential erosion beneath the racks?

I am assuming the racks your referring to are the new racks? The new drainage swale that VLC engineered sits beneath that rack system, along with the footings, the design is noted in the submission. In addition there will be a native marsh grass, shrubs and plants planted along the proposed easement along bass creek to retain the bank.

- Does Safe Harbor have any affiliation with the parking spaces across the street? Are those spaces currently used by customers/employees?

No, we do not. Customers of ours do not use it.
