Hi Fred-

Based on review of the information that you sent, the following should be incorporated into any restoration plan:

Areas which were "brush cut lightly" should be allowed to regrow. No additional plantings would be required provided that no larger trees were removed and the area was truly only brush cut.

Areas outside of the approved disturbance areas that were "clear cut and soil stripped" should be replanted with the vegetation that was there prior to the work. These include pitch pine trees (*Pinus rigida*), scrub oak (*Quercus ilicifolia*) if commercially available, and black huckleberry (*Gaylussacia baccata*).
