

MARTHA'S VINEYARD COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Adoption of regulation for the Island Wind District of Critical Planning Concern

Date & Time: Thursday, November 4, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

The Martha's Vineyard Commission will hold a Public Hearing to hear testimony and receive evidence as to whether the Commission should adopt the following regulations for the Island Wind District of Critical Planning Concern, for all Martha's Vineyard towns regarding the Water Zone, and for the Towns of Aquinnah, Chilmark, Oak Bluffs, Tisbury and West Tisbury regarding the Land Zone.

No wind energy facility may be permitted within the Land Zone or Water Zone of the Island Wind District of Critical Planning Concern unless approved by the Martha's Vineyard Commission as a Development of Regional Impact.

(Note that this is intended as an interim action with conclusion at the Annual Town Meetings of 2011.)

This hearing is held pursuant to Chapter 831 of the Acts of 1977, as amended, and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 2, and the Critical Planning District Qualifications regarding designation of a District of Critical Planning Concern (DCPC), adopted by the Commission and approved on September 8, 1975 by the Secretary of Communities and Development.
