Proposed Boundary Amendment

Acceptance of Nomination for Consideration

Aquinnah Energy District

The Martha's Vineyard Commission, at a Meeting held on Thursday, April 10, 2008, voted to accept for consideration a boundary amendment to the Aquinnah Energy District.

Proposed boundary: All lands and waters within the Town of Aquinnah, except the Indian Common Lands¹ (generally known as the Cranberry Bogs, the Clay Cliffs, and Herring Creek) and Settlement Lands².

Pursuant to Section 9 of Chapter 831 of the Acts of 1977, as amended, this memorandum shall serve as notice to the Town of Aguinnah boards and officials that a moratorium is now in place in the nominated area, and the powers and authorities of a municipality to grant development permits are now suspended.

Note that a limited moratorium has been in place covering only developments extending above 32' above mean natural grade (for land areas) and/or mean sea level (for water areas); the moratorium now covers all developments regardless of elevation.
