It is my hope that our local film makers will choose to tell the story of this family's efforts to preserve this land- how long it has taken, the terrific stress they have been put under from multiple quarters, and the fact that they have persevered. Such a film would serve as a beacon of hope for other land preservation efforts in our town and on the island.
