I am writing to express my opposition to the synthetic playing field that is being considered for installation at the regional high school.

Strike 1: it would be installed on top of the island's only aquifer, leaching carcinogens and toxic chemicals into our water supply.

Strike 2: it would have negative health effects on the athletes that use the field both for the above-mentioned toxic chemicals and for the likely increase in injuries and concussions.

Strike 3: it is being sold as "recyclable" when, in fact, there is no recycling facility available to effectively destroy or recycle it. It is a plastic product with a very long life, and when it is no longer useful as a playing field, it has nowhere to go.
