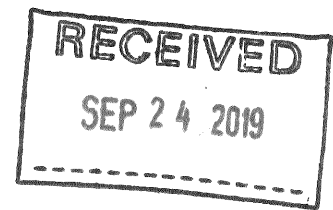


WVC

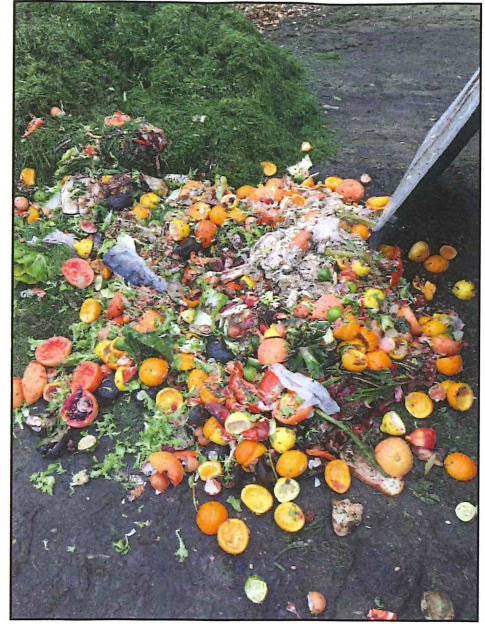
