**ISSUES:** 

1.01	Project is near complete with only a few
	remaining sprinklers to be installed on the upper
	floor
1.02	A scheduled inspection with Vineyard Have Fire
	Department to witness the flushing of the fire
	service lines with verification of the fire flow to
	the building.
1.03	Existing piping was temporarily modified to allow
	full fire service flow out through a 5" pipe to a
	manifold with (2) 2 ½" hose outlets on the
	manifold. A length of fire hose, (2), wre stretched
	from the manifold to edge of the construction
	site. Flow metering device diffusers were fitted to
	the end of the hoses, (Hose Monster). Meters
	were set up with appropriate gauges.
	The oultlets of the diffuser were wrapped to a
	burlap bag to capture any debris flushed from the
	piping.
1.04	During the initial moments of flushing procedure
	audible clanking could be heard emanating from
	the manifold piping. Several stones, 1 ½ - 2",
	were captured in the burlap bags along with
	several pounds of gravel and sand.

1.05	Flushing ran for 10 minutes and was flowing clearly at the end.
1.06	Measured flow with ample residual pressure met or exceeded the water pressure and flow requirement of the sprinkler system, namely 440 gpm @ 25 psi. Actual flow of 560 gpm was achieved during the test
1.07	Installation of the sprinkler system was near complete with the following exceptions; Temporary FDC piping modifications for flushing lines needs to be restored to its permanent piping. Sprinkler heads along eave storage units need to be installed. Sidewall style heads in lieu of pendant is acceptable.
1.08	Storage compartment partitioning was in the process of being installed and matches the plans; no issues.
1.09	Fire service was left in the off position subject to the completion of the fire alarm system.

## Discussion

With the completion of the minor incomplete work and given the successful testing of the water flow and fire service, the building's fire protection system has been installed according to the plans and is ready for occupancy.
