I would like to enter this letter into the MVC record about the Santander Bank roof replacement on Main Street in Vineyard Haven.

I am a Santander Bank customer and use that branch frequently although I live in Oak Bluffs. As a member of the Oak Bluffs Historical Commission, a retired teacher & former resident of Tisbury, I'm drawn to historic and unique architecture & Martha's Vineyard's historic preservation. I had hoped the Santander Bank would want to be committed to maintaining & supporting the properties that make the Vineyard special, especially one of their own. Santander is a Spanish corporation where tile roofs abound.

The stone bank with its red tile roof is a historic gem & the highlight of Main Street. When I saw the DRI notice, I had hoped the situation would be easily resolved by the MVC and the red asphalt tiles would be replaced by red clay tiles. However, I should not have taken that for granted, as I've seen what happens when citizens don't come forward to express concerns & assume the Commission will rule in what had seemed a clear choice to many.

So please require Santander to replace the pedantic ugly asphalt and restore the authentic more historically accurate clay type tiles on the roof.
