Todd and Emily,

Hi my name is Tim Wong, and I am lead designer for the Town of Oak Bluffs' streetscape redesign. We recently completed the renovation of downtown Circuit Ave. I am currently working on a redesign of the North Bluff area at the Circuit Ave Ext. & Seaview Ave Ext. intersection. I've attached a concept plan that we developed with public feedback in 2017. The plan aims to increase pedestrian safety, formalize vehicular traffic flow, improve stormwater function, reduce runoff, add greenspace to the area, and make a more aesthetically pleasing area for visitors coming off the ferry boats. We are now preparing an application to the Martha's Vineyard Commission, and I would like to get any comments or suggestions you may have on the plan, particularly relating to the Harbor Master's work.

I spoke to shift supervisor Aaron Wilson this past Friday at your office, and he walked me through the Harbor Master's specific needs for the site, such as the parking spaces above your fuel tanks. We concluded that if we could assign for you the whole area above the concrete pad, that would better address your parking needs. Aaron also gave his general observations on how the North Bluff area is used, such as how commercial fishers use the loading area. Our next plan will incorporate these suggestions.

If you or one of your staff members could send a brief email with your comments on the plan, that would be very helpful for the design and for our application to the MVC. My goal is to finalize the application in the next week, so if you could send over your comments in the next few days that would be great.
