Obey the Law while Riding!

Bicyclists are subject to State traffic laws and regulations, including:

- •Bicyclists 16 and under MUST wear a helmet.
- •When riding in the road, ride WITH traffic, to the right, and single file.
- •Signal with either hand when turning or stopping.
- •Bicycles ridden at night must have both front and rear lights, and pedal reflectors.
- •Riding on sidewalks is permissible, except in downtown areas where posted.
- •Parked bicycles may not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic on roads, sidewalks or bike paths.

Be Safe while Riding!

Cyclists have the right to ride in the road even when a path is adjacent the road. However, the narrow roads that are part of the Island's charm are also used by trucks and buses. Evaluate your riding skills accordingly.

Beware of sand and debris on roads and paths, soft road shoulders, and storm drains.

Helmets on adult cyclists can prevent a minor spill from being life threatening.


Don't handicap your safety by riding with cell phones, headphones or ear buds.
