I grew up watching my all-star athlete dad proudly work on a sales team that was installing turf into the astrodome in Texas circa 1965, he believed in Monsanto.

He was a stick ball, street ball, basketball kid in the Bronx. He played sports on weekends my whole life, on a court, on a field and he was always comparing the field and the turf; and, over time his mind changed.

With every "positive" of turf came a host of issues, and he left the company many decades later - he was a company man - his career spanned my childhood.

He left Monsanto feeling athletes really need the earth and all who take care of it. He loved the community of sports.

Our home always had a lot of astroturf mats everywhere - and he shared them all the time - he said they lasted forever.

Forty years later, when he gave his stockpile away to organizations who didn't have resources for flooring, he knew that they would last forever.

He had refused to throw them away, and that was his way of recycling the unrecyclable.
