1. Project – DRI 703 AmeriGas Relocation – Pre-Public Hearing Review

Applicant: Titan Propane LLC, d/b/a AmeriGas
Proposal: Relocation of two 30,000-gallon propane tanks from 7 North Line Road to 6 North Line Road in the Airport Business Park.
Location: 6 North Line Road, Edgartown (Airport Business Park). Map 24, Lot 2.31 (1.8 acres)
Purpose: To review the project and discuss if it is prepared for public hearing.

2. Project – DRI 550-M4 Mansion House Parking Lot – Modification Review

Applicant: SHG, LLC; Sherman & Susan Goldstein; Geoghan Coogan
Proposal: Repurposing of two lots on Cromwell Lane for Mansion House parking.
Location: 10 & 12 Cromwell Lane, Tisbury. Map 7-F, Lots 15 & 16.7 (approx. 0.12 acres).
Purpose: To review the project and decide on a recommendation to the full Commission as to whether this is a significant enough change to the approved DRI that it requires a public hearing review as a Development of Regional Impact.

3. Project – DRI 566-M5 Island Energy Relocation – Modification Review

Applicant: Island Energy, Inc. (Brian McBride)
Proposal: Relocation of Island Energy office and service operation from 44 Evelyn Way to 7 North Line Road in the Airport Business Park, while maintaining one existing storage tank and one parking space at 44 Evelyn Way.
Location: 44 Evelyn Way, Tisbury. Map 22-C, Lot 7.1 (approx. 0.26 acres); 7 North Line Road, Edgartown. Map 24, Lot 2.21 (1.4 acres).
Purpose: To review the project and decide on a recommendation to the full Commission as to whether this is a significant enough change to the approved DRI that it requires a public hearing review as a Development of Regional Impact.
