
Dear Mr. Turner:

USDA-Rural Development awarded Tisbury \$1,240,500 of loan/grant funding in June 2014, and the Town signed the loan agreements for this funding on August 6, 2014. Tisbury has up to five years, or through August 2019, to use this funding.

Tisbury is actively involved in the planning for the expansion of our existing sewer service area to encompass the Lake Tashmoo watershed area in order to meet our DEP-mandated Total Maximum Daily Load discharge thresholds to this water body. Identifying the geographical limits of this sewer service area and receiving Town Meeting approval to expand it involves a municipal process that will ultimately require Town Meeting approval, likely at the 2018 Annual Town Meeting.

In the short term, the Town is still committed to installing sewer service on High Point Lane and consists of installing either grinder pumps or a small pump station with a force main/gravity pipe collection system. The Town is committed to providing sewer service to the properties on High Point Lane and would like to design, bid and construct this sewer extension in calendar years 2017-18. The system would be sized to accommodate additional future flows from State Road in the future as the Tashmoo sewer service area is implemented.
