- 2. All abutters are notified of the request for a permit for a windmill, turbine of any height specifically by mail, email, phone
- 3. public meetings for comment are held
- 4. each request for a permit for a turbine must include a management plan which is crafted by the person requesting a turbine and the abutters
- 5. Appropriate committees consider reasonable parameters having thoroughly studied all pertinent laws.
- 6. No turbine request is to move forward without rights of abutters being included in the process.
