NARRATIVE

On the above date and time officers were asked to call the communication center in regards to a non-emergency 911 call. I, Officer Seth Harlow called and was informed that the owner of 3 Uncas Ave, who resides in Tisbury year round, had called to report some suspicious activity at her rental home. The caller, Grace REEVES, stated that the house was closed up for the winter and when they went there to get it ready for the rental season it appeared that someone had been

squatting there.

I called REEVES (508-693-0908) to see if she had any more information to add. She advised me that there were sheets and blankets left on a couch that were not there when the house was closed up. She also advised that the back door to the house didn't lock and she gave me permission to check the house.

I then responded to the residence and checked the house. There house was very poorly kept and there was what looked like older damage and mess throughout. I did observe the couch where someone had been sleeping but there was no further evidence of squatters. The disarray appeared to be older, possibly from the previous renters. I called back REEVES and informed her of my findings. I suggested that she have the door fixed and report any further suspicious activity.
