Capt. Monteiro,

Good morning, as per our conversation earlier today regarding the recent Martha's Vineyard Gazette (September 24, 2021) regarding traffic projections for the proposed terminal. The reported "36 additional trips to the site per day at peak summer , with travel limited during the early morning and late evening" was referring to vehicular traffic and not vessel trips.

As stated below and shown on the attached plan, the new O&M terminal will have three (3) vessel berths. The proposed crew transfer vessel (CTV) operations are as follows:

1. One (1) year-round vessel (weather permitting) leaving early each morning and returning late afternoon.
2. A second (2<sup>nd</sup>) summer-only vessel on the same schedule.
3. Possible third (3<sup>rd</sup>) vessel for specific short-duration tasks.

The O&M Terminal operations will coordinate vessel trips with SSA ferry schedule.
