

## MARTHA'S VINEYARD COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Island Road District of Critical Planning Concern Proposal to Designate Manter's Path as a Special Way in West Tisbury

The Martha's Vineyard Commission will hold a Public Hearing to hear testimony and receive evidence as to whether the Commission should designate the following new way in the Special Ways Zone of the Island Road District of Critical Planning Concern in the Town of West Tisbury:

Area under Consideration:

Within twenty feet of either side of the centerline of <u>Manter's Path</u>: As shown on Assessors' Map 31: from the juncture of lots 6 and 69 at a point approximately 200 feet from the centerline of Tiahs Cove Road; across Tiahs Cove Road to the juncture of lots 102.21 and 111.3; in a generally northeasterly direction along the property boundaries; across Blackthorn Road; approximately 200 feet along the boundary of lots 106.4 and 116 to meet the Special Way know as Scrubby Neck Road and Watcha Path.

Copies of the nomination are on file at the Commission offices for inspection or by e-mail or on the Commission website <u>www.mvcommission.org</u>. Written testimony may be submitted prior to or during the hearing.

This hearing is held pursuant to Chapter 831 of the Acts of 1977, as amended, and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 2, and the Critical Planning District Qualifications regarding designation of a District of Critical Planning Concern (DCPC), adopted by the Commission and approved on September 8, 1975 by the Secretary of Communities and Development.
