The Martha's Vineyard Commission will hold a Public Hearing **at 7:15 P.M., on Thursday, January 22, 2015,** at the offices of the **Martha's Vineyard Commission**, Stone Building, 33 New York Avenue, Oak Bluffs, MA, 02557, to hear testimony and receive evidence as to whether the Commission should:

FIND CONFORMANCE OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF EDGARTOWN:

To determine if regulations proposed to govern the **MARTHA'S VINEYARD LAWN FERTILIZER CONTROL DISTRICT** in the **Town of Edgartown**, as amended on the floor and voted by the 2014 Annual Town Meeting, conform to the Guidelines for development as specified in the Commission's designation.

This hearing is held pursuant to Chapter 831 of the Acts of 1977, as amended, and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 2, and the Critical Planning District Qualifications regarding designation of a District of Critical Planning Concern (DCPC), adopted by the Commission and approved on September 8, 1975 by the Secretary of Communities and Development.
