On April 7-08 I received a phone call from a person connected to IAHT at 6:47 PM. He claimed he was doing me a favor, because he had done some work for me in the past, by informing me that the politically connected people of the Island Affordable Housing Fund and the Island Affordable Housing Trust would see to it that my residential condo project would not get through the M.V. Commission unless I wrote a retraction to my letter to the M.V. Commission regarding Bradley Square, as appeared in the M.V. Times. He also strongly suggested I become a vocal supporter of the project. The fact that he pressed me for an answer 3 times during the conversation told me that he was reporting back to his "people". I have to presume he is your mouthpiece and I want to inform you that I will not succumb to "Political Extortion" by you, IAHF, IAHT or anyone else. I told him I would take his warning "under advisement" and I decided, in about two seconds, a lot of good men died to protect my freedom of speech and my right to voice an opinion and out of respect for the "Greatest Generation" I will be damned if this pocket of corruption, operating under the guise of "Affordable Housing," will put words in my mouth. If you are not responsible for this threat I suggest you find out who is and remove them immediately. You can expect serious scrutiny of your (non-profit??) by all relevant local, state and federal agencies in the near future.
